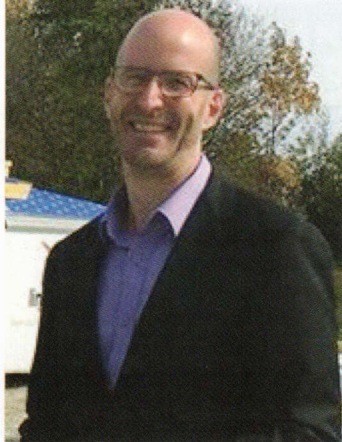

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

For over three and a half years, I have had the privilege of being a part of a team that has changed the way end-of-life care is being delivered in Grey and Bruce. It was a gradual process, we had a lot to learn as a staff and as a health provider, and we have come a long way from when our community hospice was first approved. But now there is an important next step before us: the construction of Chapman House.

Our commitment to the region is clear and our hospice team has dedicated themselves to providing expert care to loved ones from our community. Maybe you have already heard about how important the hospice was to someone close to you or know a family that came to us when we were needed. But what you may not know is that on top of the specialized education our registered nurses complete, three have continued their studies and achieved their certification in palliative nursing from the Canadian Nursing Association. Or that we now have a new palliative physician to serve our region, working alongside Owen Sound's Dr. Hilli Huff, and Hanover's Dr. Susan Batten. Or that our personal support workers continue to develop skills specific to our service and we have more volunteers trained in the Fundamentals of Palliative Care. We have made our entire team stronger to better serve our community.

Now we need a new home. Our temporary space simply cannot manage the number of people who need our hospice. We're bursting at the seams.

The construction of Chapman House is the most important chapter in our story. It is being built with patient comfort in mind, and with their family and friends in our hearts. It has been designed to help us reach more patients in a space built specifically for end-of-life care. It has been designed to serve the region for generations to come.

We are proud to have the support of so many across Grey and Bruce and are grateful that the province has committed to more beds in our new space. But to get to where we need to go, we need your help.

On behalf of our volunteer Board of Directors, the nurses, personal support workers, volunteers, allied health professionals but most importantly the patients and families in our care, I am asking you now for your support and for you to donate toward the construction of Chapman House. With your help, you can help us reach our goal to have the project paid for before the end of this year. Please help us build our new home for hospice.
