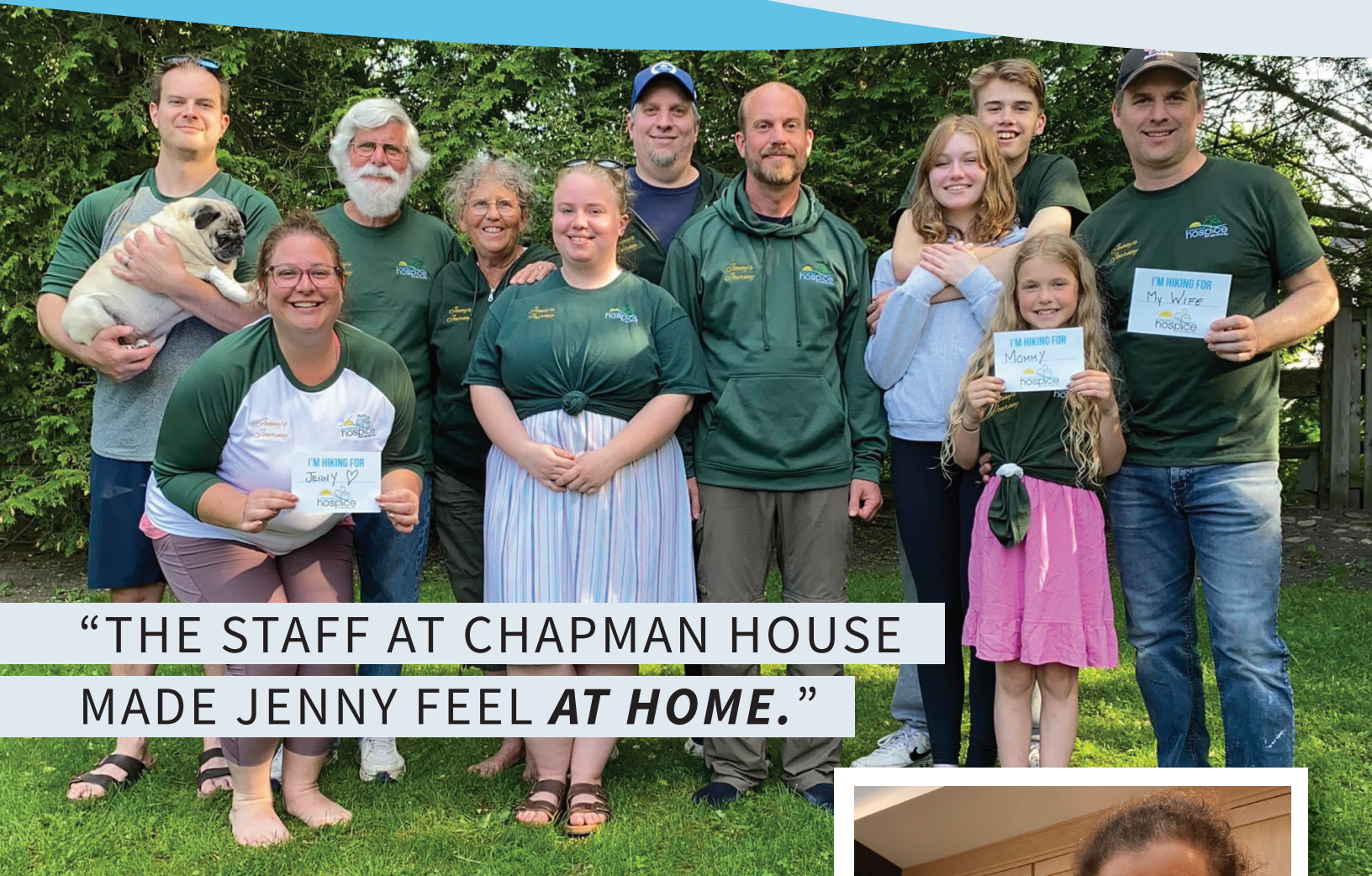


THE STORY OF *Home*

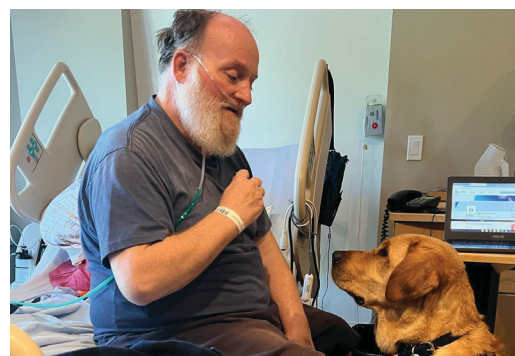
Bill made his room **HOME** with some of his favourite jerseys from his collection.
