Policy Statement

It is the policy of Grey Bruce Hospice Inc. (GBH) to promote and develop safe practices to ensure the well-being of residents and staff.

Commitment Statement

216.01 Safety Plan

Our Safety Plan is a living process that is monitored and evaluated on an ongoing basis by all affiliated with GBH. The progress is monitored through the Joint Health and Safety Committee and the *Continuous Improvement Goals*. The Medical Director will make recommendations to the Executive Committee regarding quality improvement, who will in turn consider the policy changes.

216.02 Responsibilities

The Executive Director with the JHSC and Human Resources Coordinator shall be responsible for the development, implementation, support, monitoring and evaluation of the Safety Plan.

216.03 Review Cycle

This policy will be reviewed at least every three years.
